**Analysis & Visualization of MOVEment:
Focus on Tangible Results**

COST IC0903 MOVE meeting, March 4-5, 2012
HafenCity University, Hamburg, Germany

On March 4-5 2013, members of the COST Action MOVE (IC0903) will gather at the HafenCity University in Hamburg, Germany, to discuss collaborations and future research directions in analysis and visualisation of movement data. This workshop is the last before the final Action meeting and it will **especially focus on tangible results** from collaboration through the Action. Sessions dedicated to specific topics related to the Action will be set up, in particular to showcase successful on-going collaboration between members. If your contribution is accepted, you will be asked to prepare an **oral presentation**. We especially welcome inter-disciplinary contributions providing results which can be easily advertised outside the Action (specific websites, videos and animations, graphics ...).

We invite five types of contributions :

1. Showcases:

Submit a **one A4** page description of a **showcase** or a **data challenge** that you organized or attended in 2012, including a description of results and outcomes. If you have an as-yet-unexplored movement dataset, present an idea for a future showcase.

2. Recent research results:

Submit a **two A4** pages summary of a **conference paper** that you recently presented/will shortly present at another venue or of a **journal paper** that is currently accepted/has recently appeared in print. Let us know: 1) where your work has/will appear and 2) to which WG(s) your contribution can be attributed. This gives you an opportunity to present your latest and hottest research results related to the COST Action.

3. STSM reports:

If you participated in a **Short-Term Scientific Mission (STSM)** recently, submit a **two A4** pages report, describing the results and listing any (potential) publications arising from your mission.

4. Research challenges:

Submit a **two A4** pages abstract with a description of a **future research challenge**. This category is for open problems, future plans and blue sky thinking, therefore please, do not include anything already published or under review elsewhere.

All contributions will be reviewed by the Programme co-chairs and the members of the Programme committee. Reviews will form the **basis for travel reimbursement decisions**. Priority will be given to joint contributions involving at least two (preferably internationally) separate MOVE partners. One author (who has to be a WG member of at least one WG) from each accepted contribution will be offered full reimbursement of travel costs to the meeting to present the contribution.

- Submission deadline: January 18, 2013
- Acceptance decision: February 1, 2013
- Meeting in Hamburg: March 4-5, 2013
